- 1. **Monday** (Noun): The second day of the week
- 2. **Night** (Noun): The period of time between sunset and sunrise each day
- 3. There's (Contraction): An abbreviation for "there is"
- 4. **Mouse** (*Noun*): A small grey or brown mammal with a long tail
- 5. **House** (*Noun*): A building in which usually a single family lives
- 6. **Know** (Verb): To be aware of; to understand
- 7. **Play(ing)** (Verb): To use a musical instrument to make music
- 8. **P-i-a-n-o** (Noun): A piano; a large, musical instrument played by pressing keys
- 9. **Plink plink plunk** (Noun): The sound made when a piano is played
- 10. **Tuesday** (Noun): The third day of the week
- 11. **Birdy** (Noun): A bird; a small animal that can fly, has a beak and is covered with feathers
- 12. **Window** (Noun): An opening that lets light and fresh air into a house or other building
- 13. **Tiny** (Adjective): Very small
- 14. Fella (Noun): A fellow; a young man
- 15. **Sing(ing)** (Verb): To make music with one's voice
- 16. A cappella (Adjective): Without musical instruments playing at the same time
- 17. **Twee tweet** (*Noun*): The sound made by a bird
- 18. **Wednesday** (Noun): The fourth day of the week
- 19. **Sink** (*Noun*): An small, open, tub used for cleaning, which can drain or hold water
- 20. **Hear** (Verb): To notice a sound
- 21. **Drip(ping)** (Verb): To fall in tiny amounts, as a liquid would from a leaky faucet
- 22. **Little** (Adjective): Small
- 23. **Drip drip drop** (*Noun*): The sound make by dripping water
- 24. **Thursday** (Noun): The fifth day of the week
- 25. **Baby** (Noun): A young child, usually one who cannot walk or talk yet
- 26. Nearby (Adverb): Close, in terms of distance
- 27. Lallapalooza (Noun): A strong young man
- 28. **Hush** (Verb): To be quiet
- 29. **Cry(ing)** (Verb): To make a wailing sound that signals distress, as a baby does
- 30. The blues (Noun): Music sung or played about being sad
- 31. A wah wah wah (Noun): The sound of a baby crying
- 32. **Friday** (*Noun*): The sixth day of the week
- 33. **Scat** (Verb): To sing, making up the words and sounds as one goes along
- 34. **Skobba dobba do-bop be-bop shoo** (Noun): The sound of scat singing
- 35. **Saturday** (Noun): The seventh day of the week
- 36. Conductor (Noun): A person who leads an orchestra
- 37. **Tonight** (*Noun*): The evening and night following the current day
- 38. **Symphony** (Noun): A pleasant mix of sounds occurring at the same time
- 39. **Sunday** (*Noun*): The first day of the week
- 40. **Shhhhh** (Interjection): A sound made to suggest that people be quiet
- 41. **Disturb** (Verb): To bother or annoy
